

The **Donor Acquisition Specialist (DA)** is responsible to improve Zeta Psi's stewardship and fundraising effectiveness and efficiency focusing on undergraduate members and new donors to the organization. The position is remote.

The principal deliverables for the DA are, but not limited to the following:

- Leadership of Giving Day programs primarily focused on new donor acquisition.
- Promoting and growing a revamped recurring giving program to support chapters.
- Stewardship of Zeta Psi members from associate membership through the transition into alumni donors.
- Managing the fulfillment of membership kits for new members.

Requirements:

- Self-starter who can meet established timelines with minimal oversight in a totally remote environment and who can monitor handoffs and potential gaps to prevent fumbles.
- A strong sense of mission to help students and alumni improve.
- The ability to effectively communicate that to stakeholders both verbally and in writing.

Desirable Experiences

• Membership in Zeta Psi is not a requirement for the position, but membership in a Greek letter organization is a plus.

Salary, Benefits and Disclosures:

- This position is intended as an early career position where you will have the opportunity to learn and grow. Zeta Psi seeks an individual who will make a two-year commitment to the position.
- Zeta Psi offers health care, unlimited PTO, holidays, a highly flexible work environment and a 401(k) with match after one year of employment. The expected starting salary is \$37,000/year.
- The position requires the candidate to be eligible to work in the United States.
- Zeta Psi is an at-will employer.
